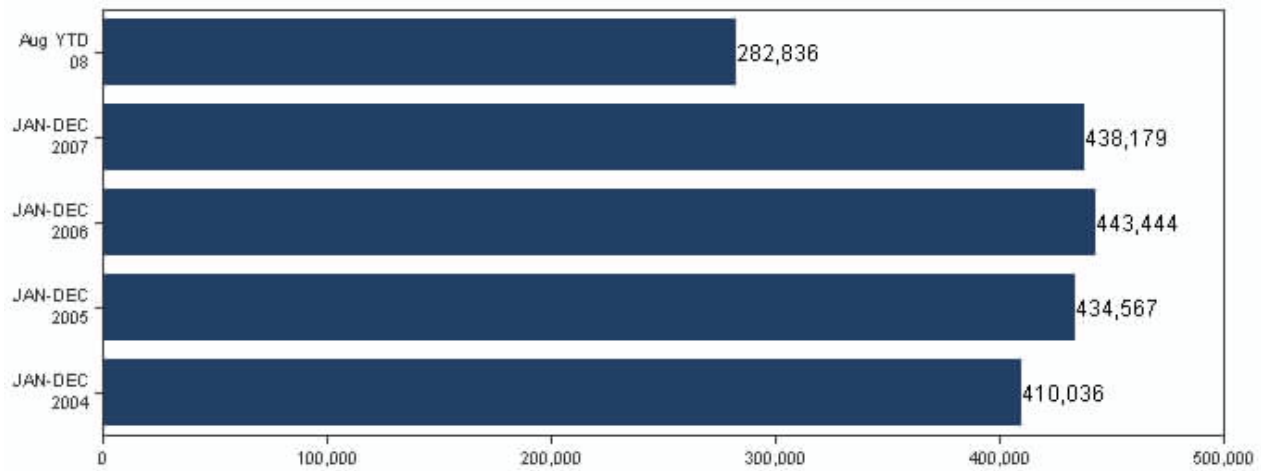

Enplanements/Corpus Christi International Airport

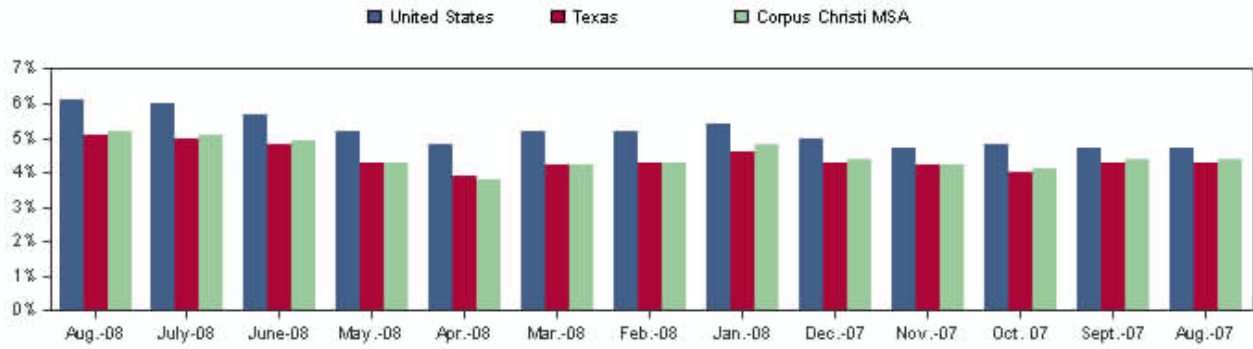

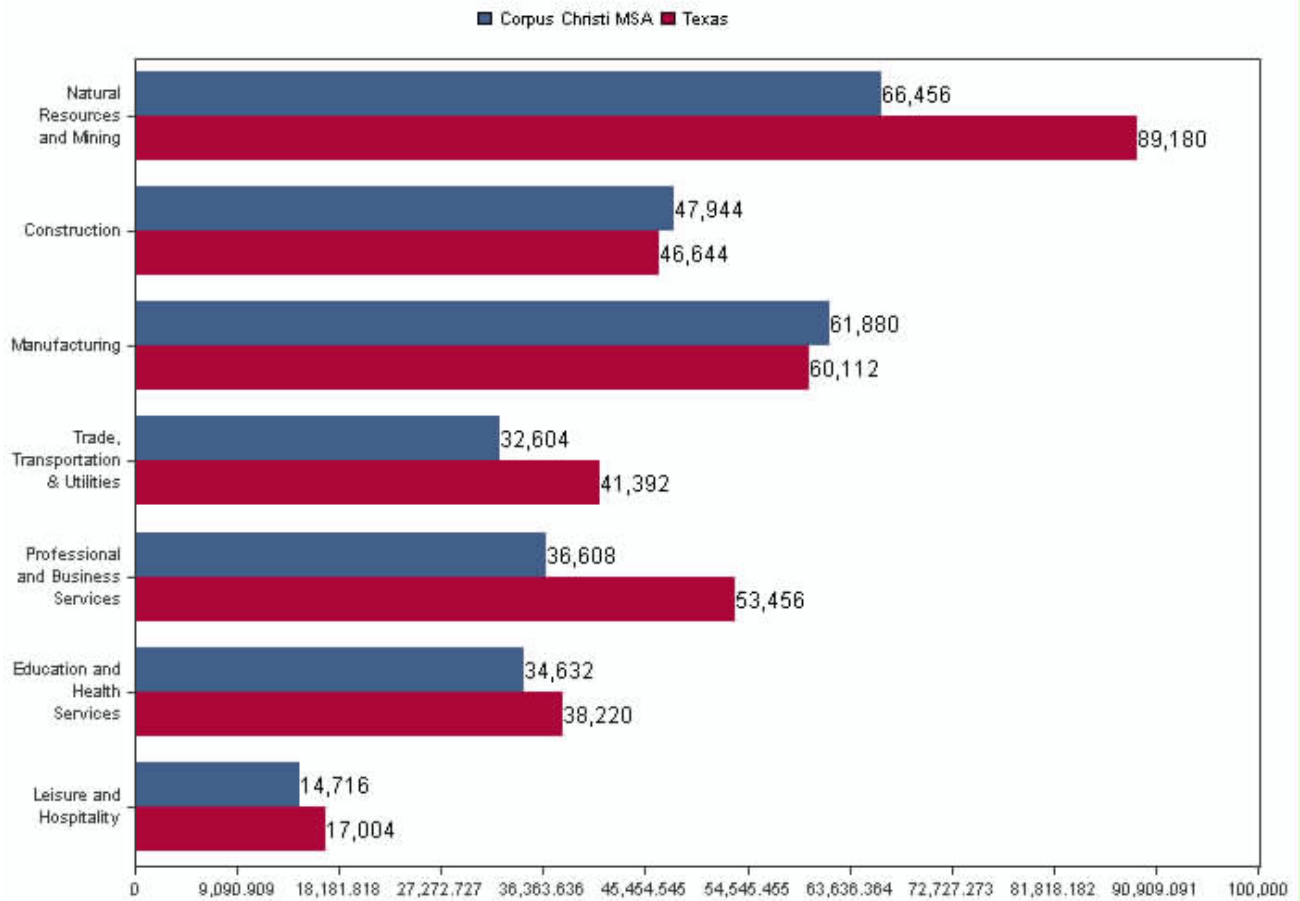
