Median household income is **\$3.6K below** the national median household income of \$55.3K.

As of 2017 the region's population **increased by 5.2%** since 2012, growing by 22,665. Population is expected to **increase by 3.2%** between 2017 and 2022, adding 14,854.

From 2012 to 2017, jobs **increased by 3.6%** in Corpus Christi, TX from 203,758 to **211,106**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2%** by 4.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 59.4% to 56.5%** between 2012 and 2017.

Concerning educational attainment, **12.2% of Corpus Christi, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.2% below the national average), and **6.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.0% below the national average).

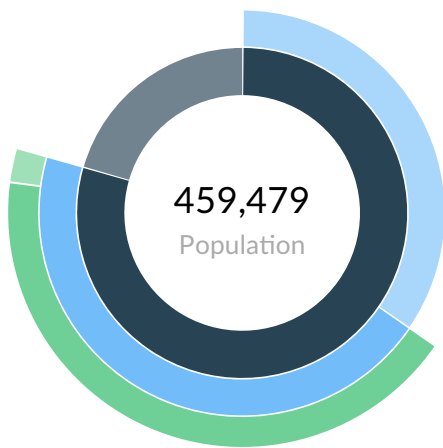
The top three industries in 2017 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Nonresidential Building Construction.

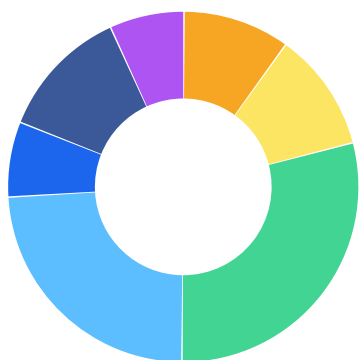

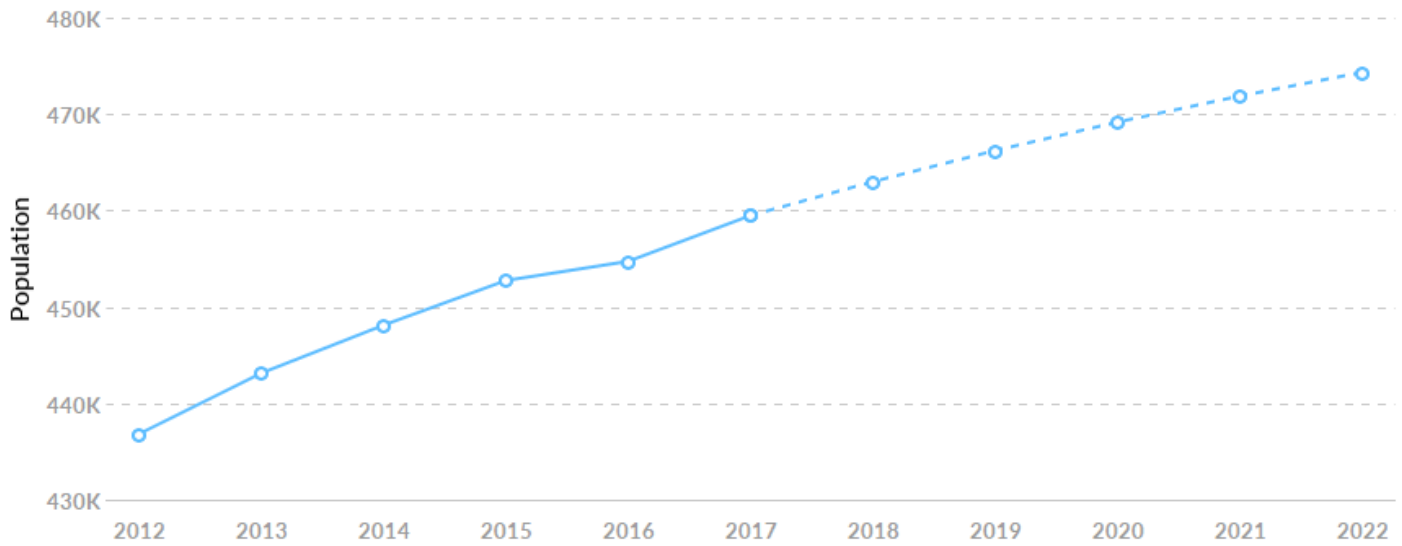

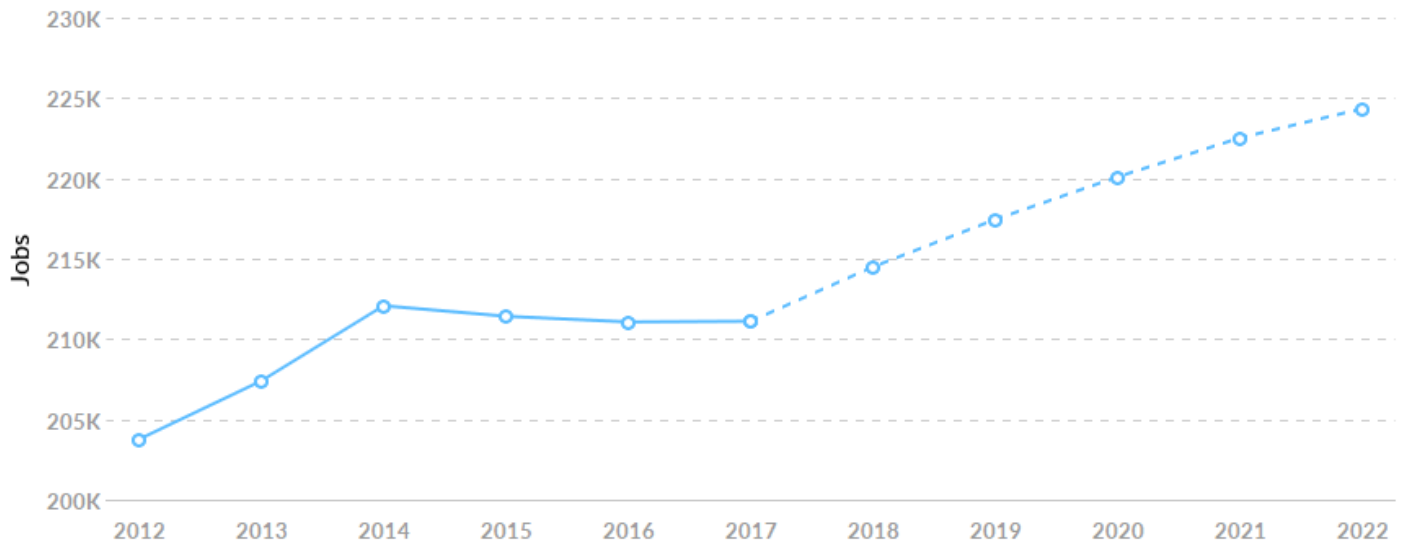

Job Trends

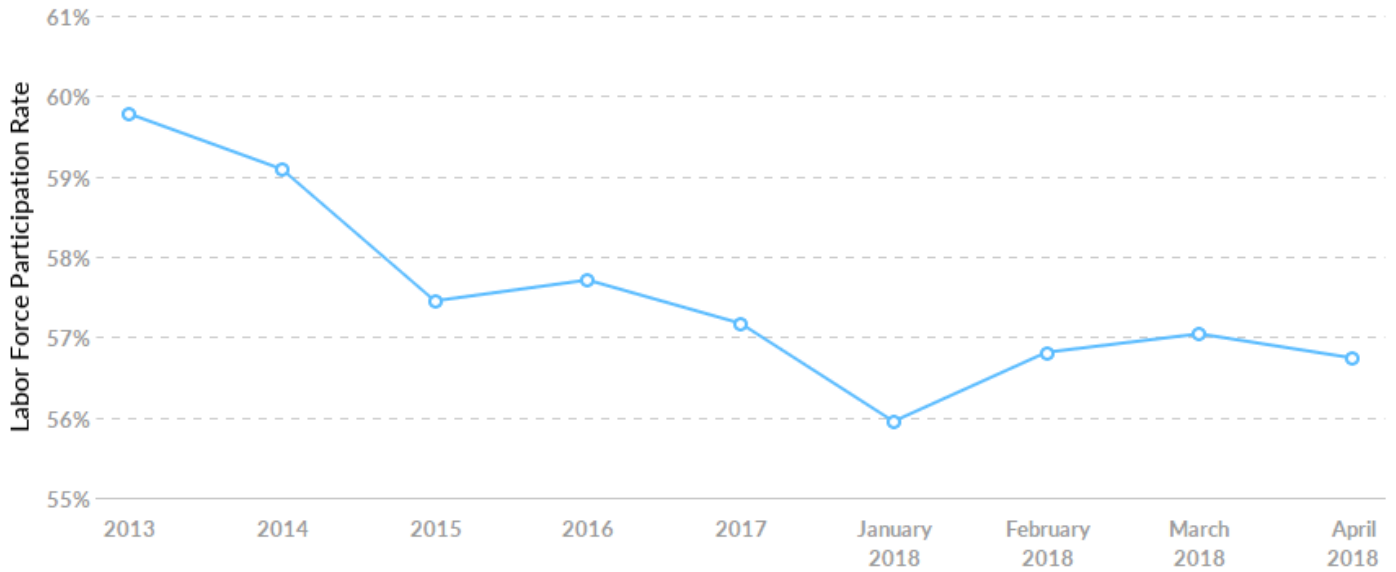

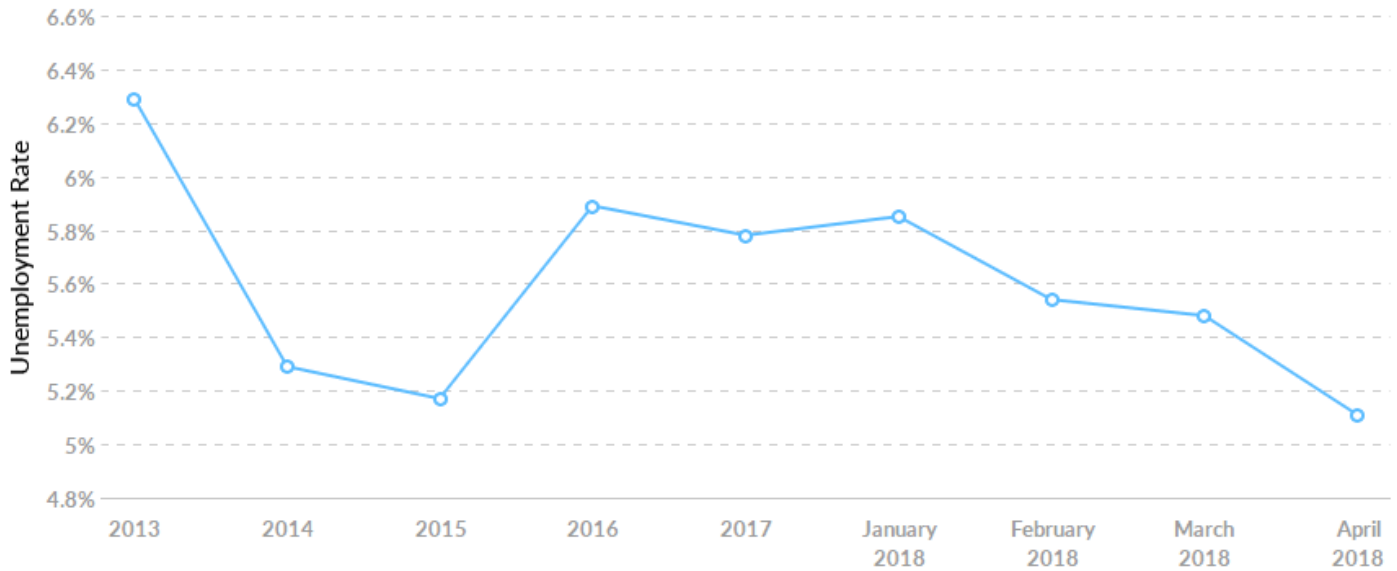

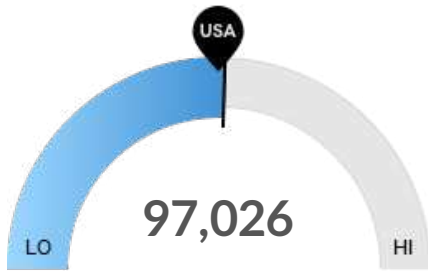
Unemployment Rate Trends

Corpus Christi, TX had an April 2018 unemployment rate of 5.11%, **decreasing from 6.29%** 5 years before.



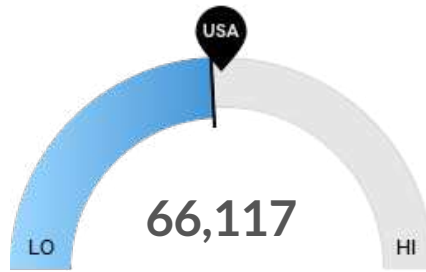

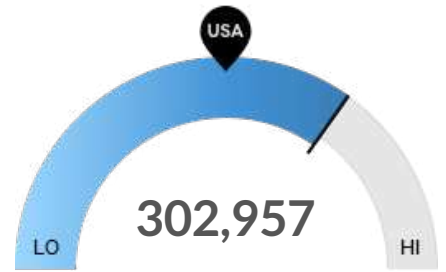
Millennials

Corpus Christi, TX has 97,026 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 94,369.



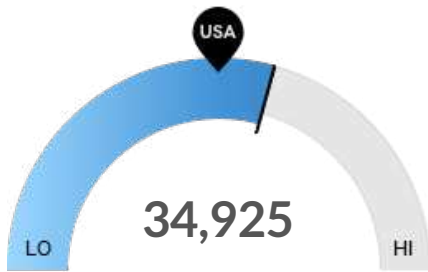
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Corpus Christi, TX. The national average for an area this size is 69,300 people 65 or older, while there are 66,117 here.



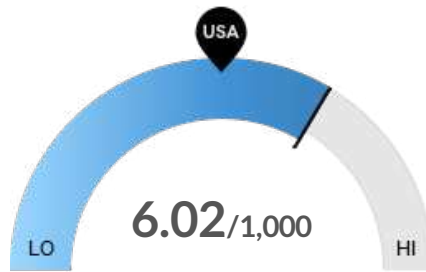
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Corpus Christi, TX. The national average for an area this size is 176,131 racially diverse people, while there are 302,957 here.



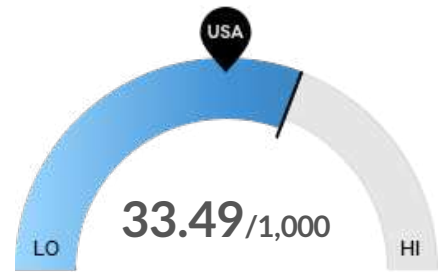
Veterans

Corpus Christi, TX has 6.02 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.75 per 1,000 people.



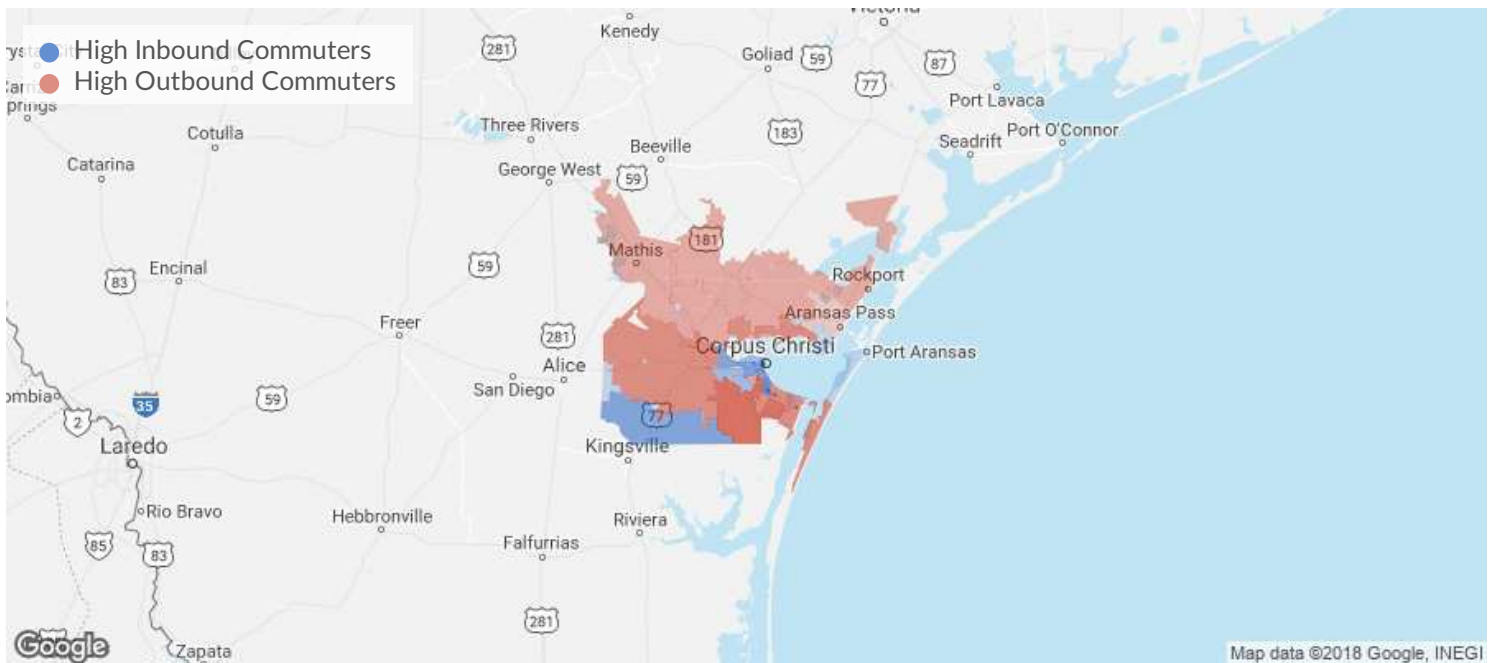
Property Crime

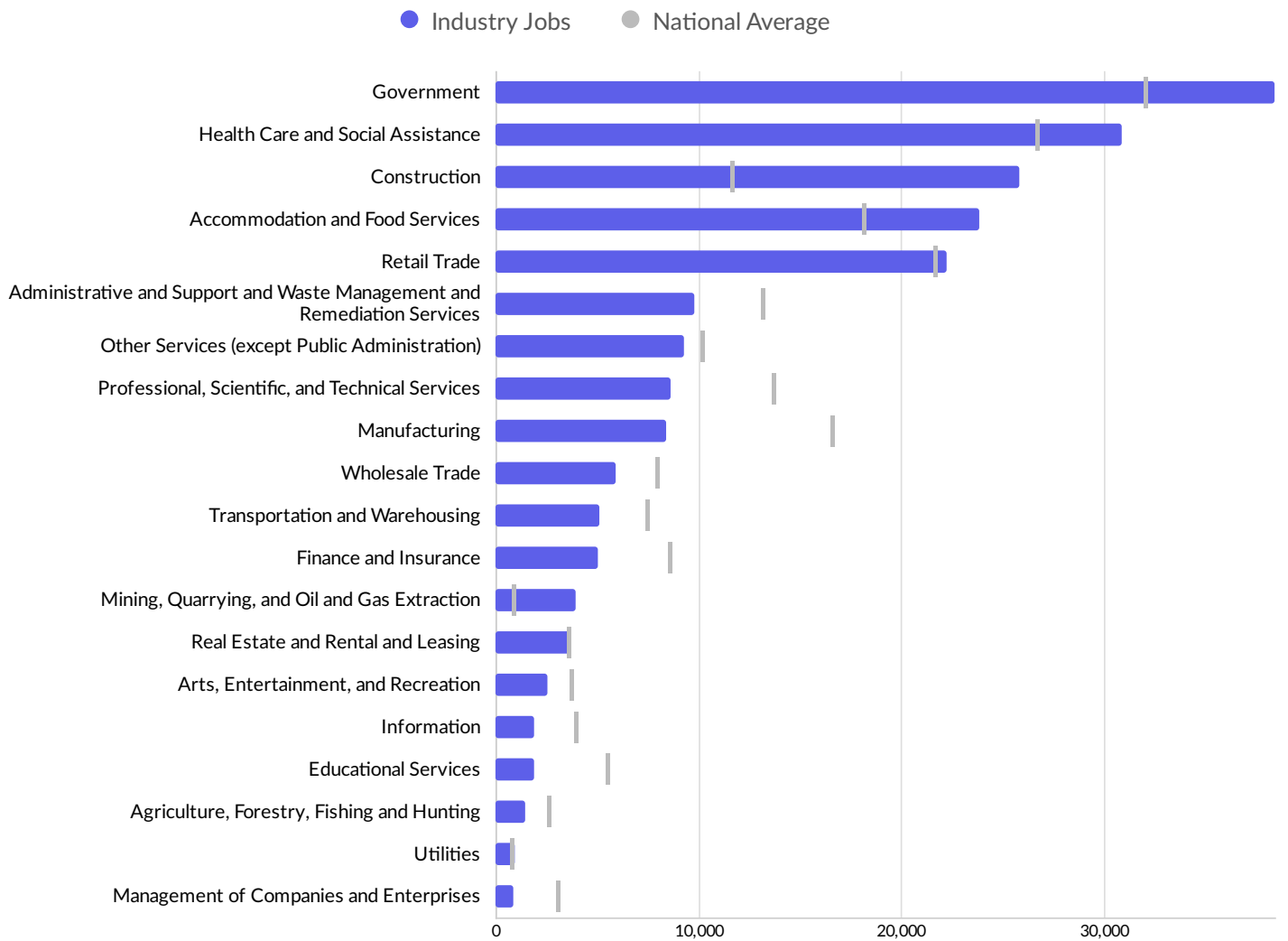

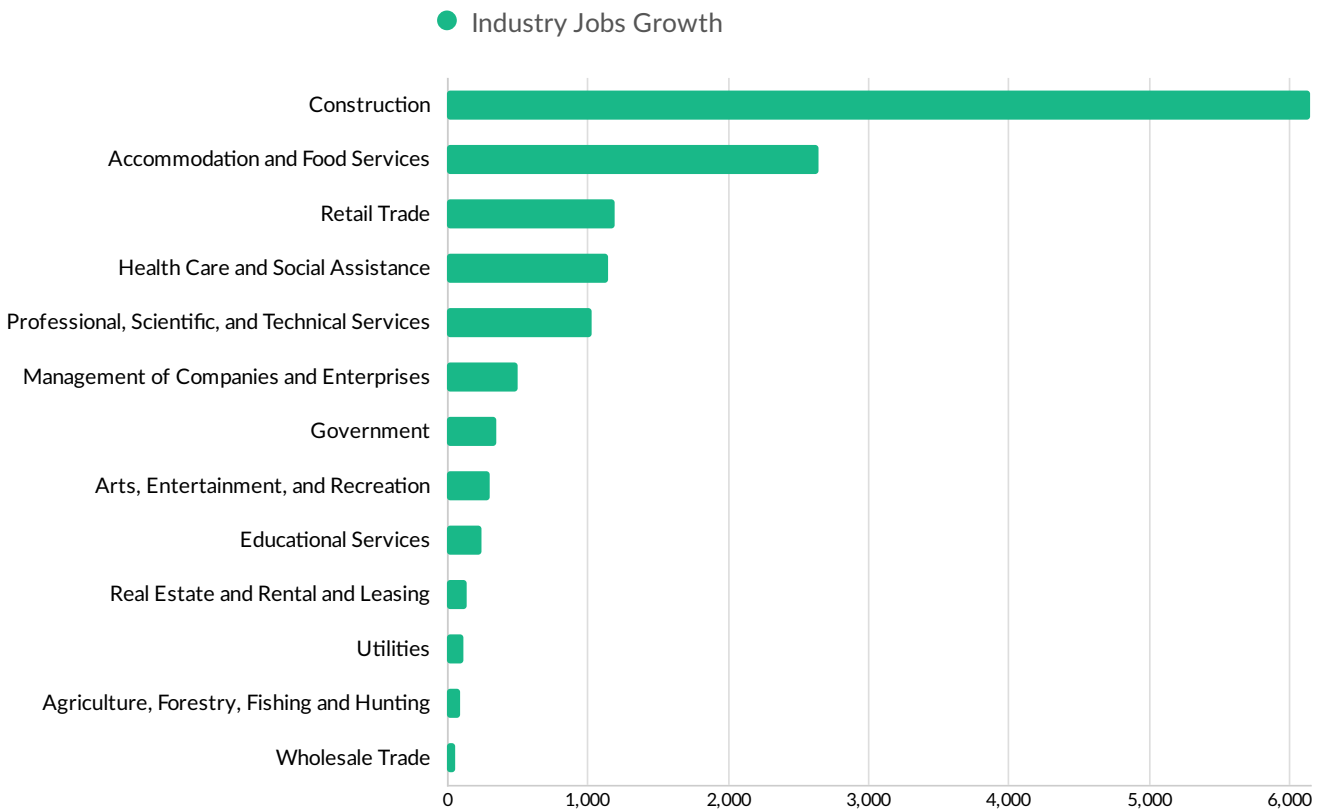

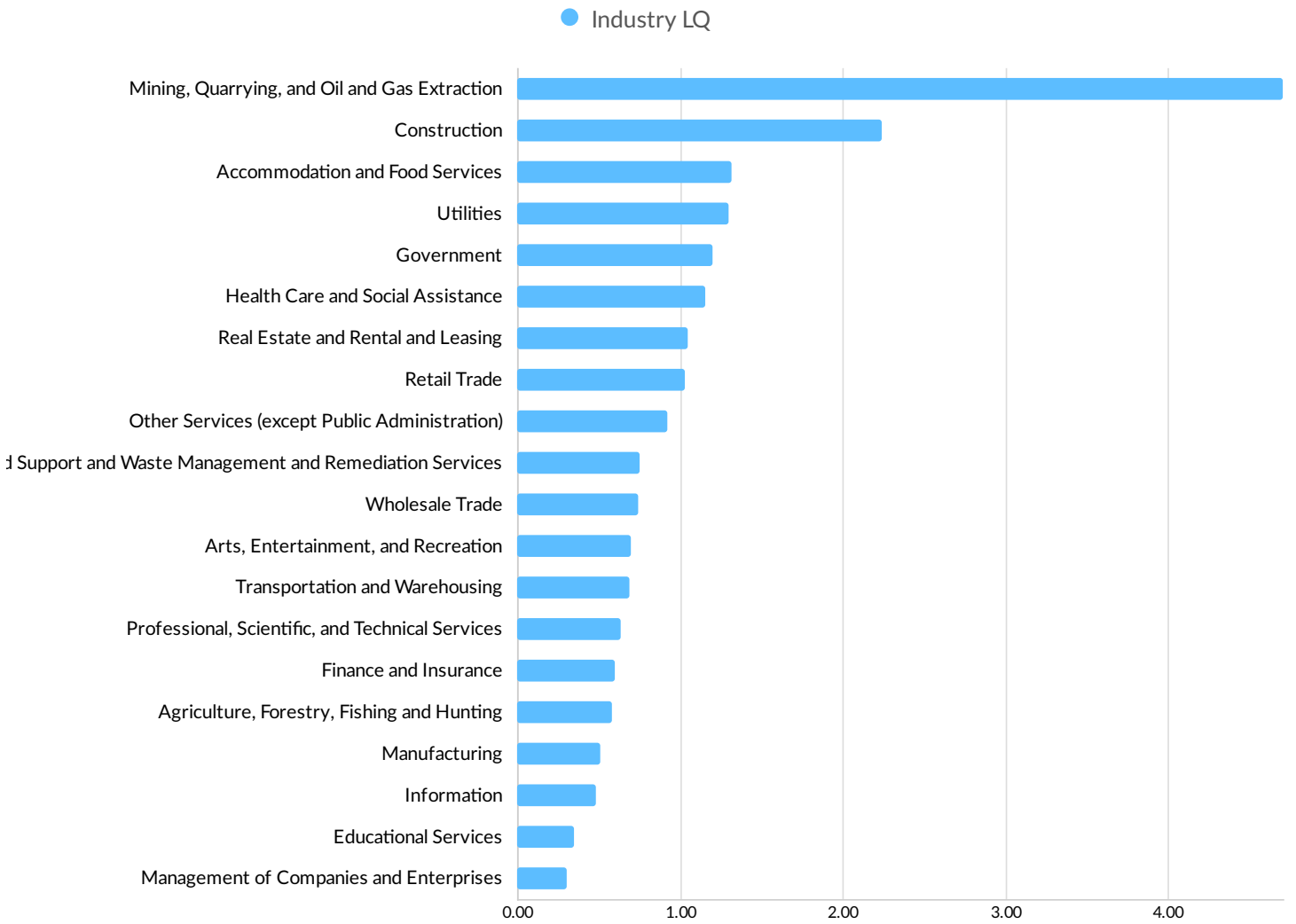

Top Growing Industries



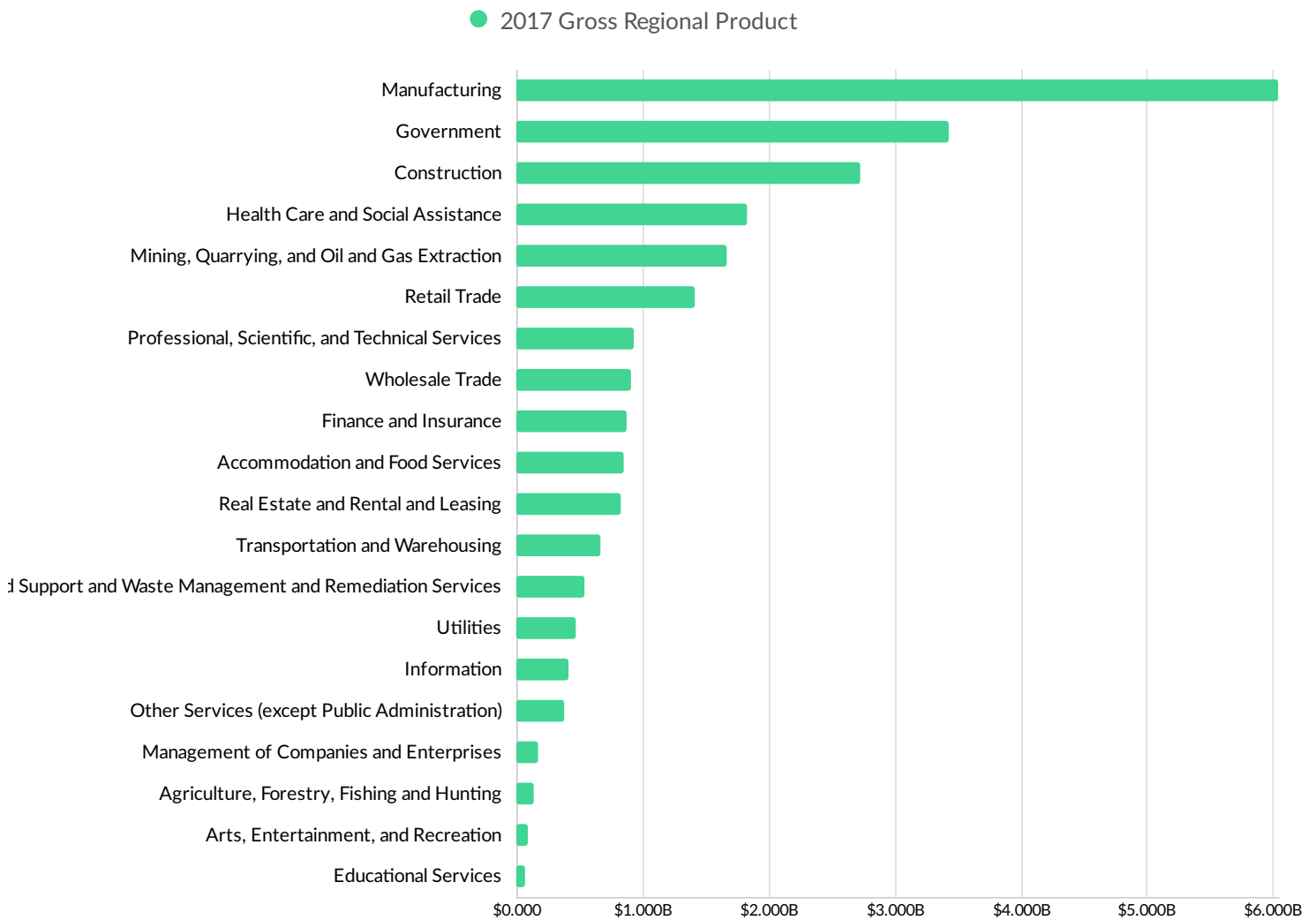

Top Industry LQ



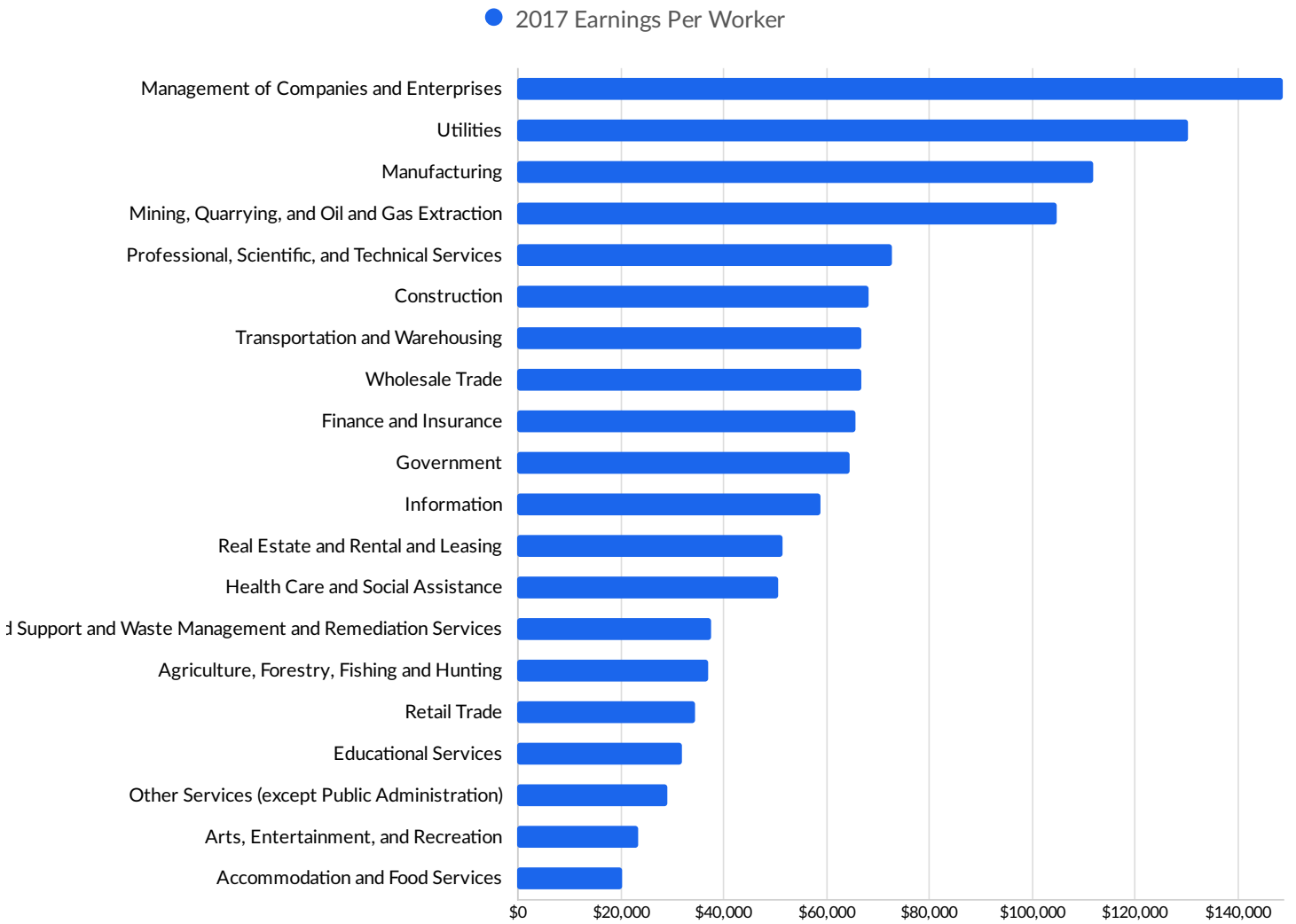

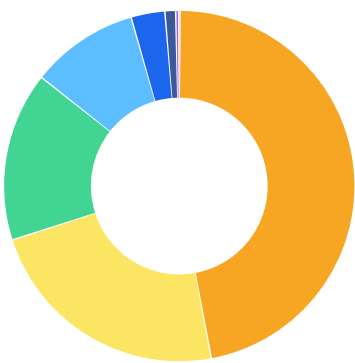

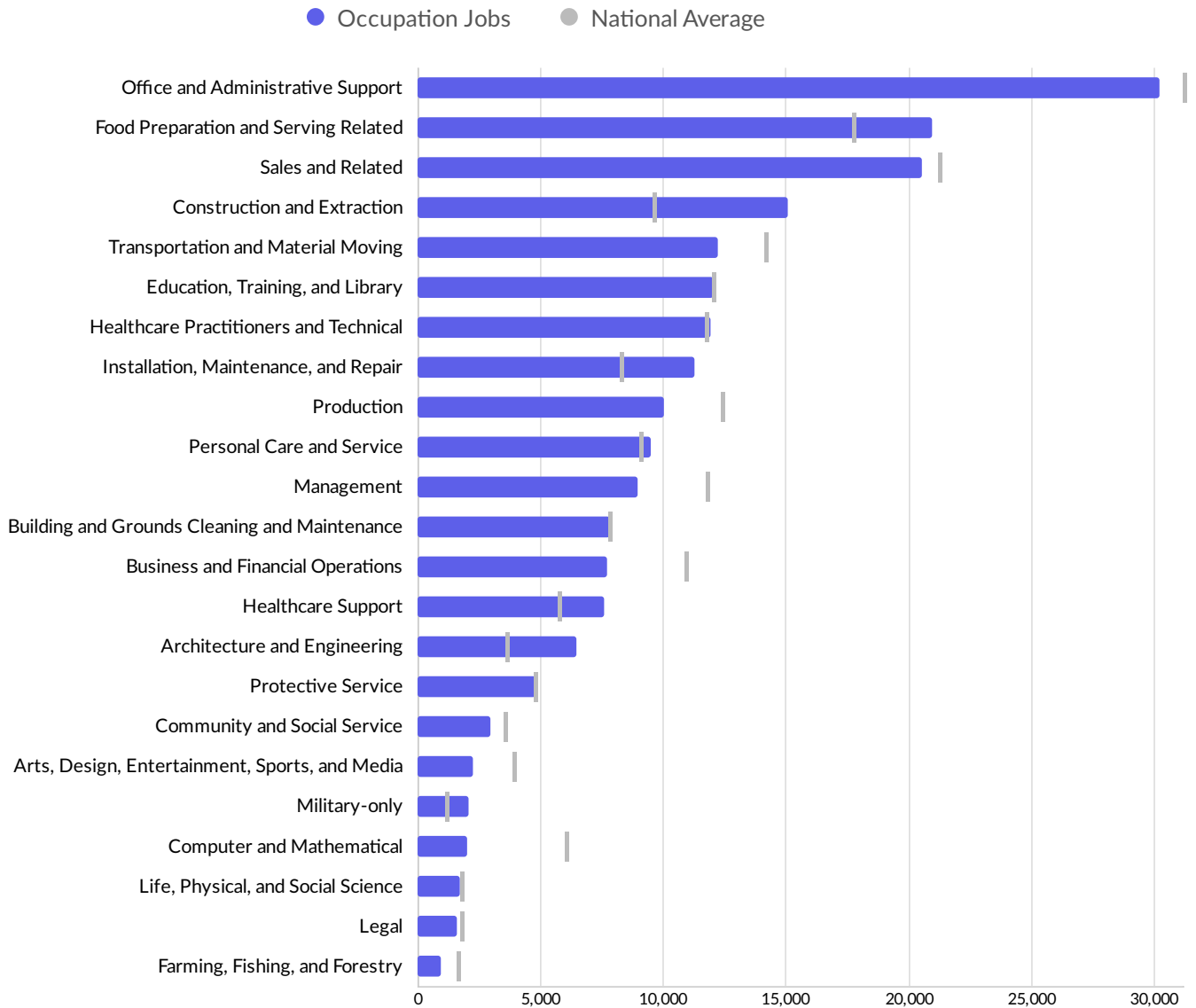

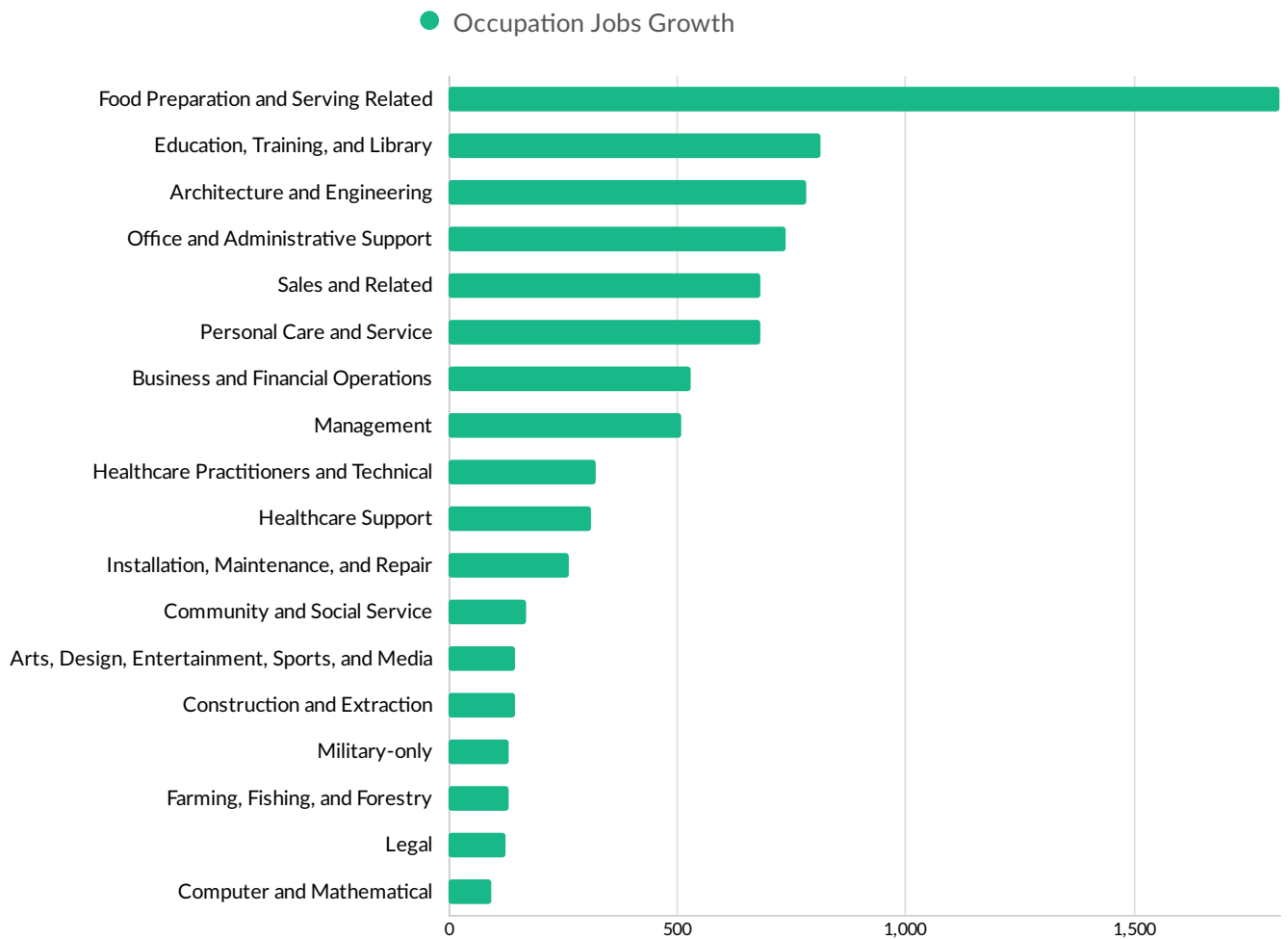

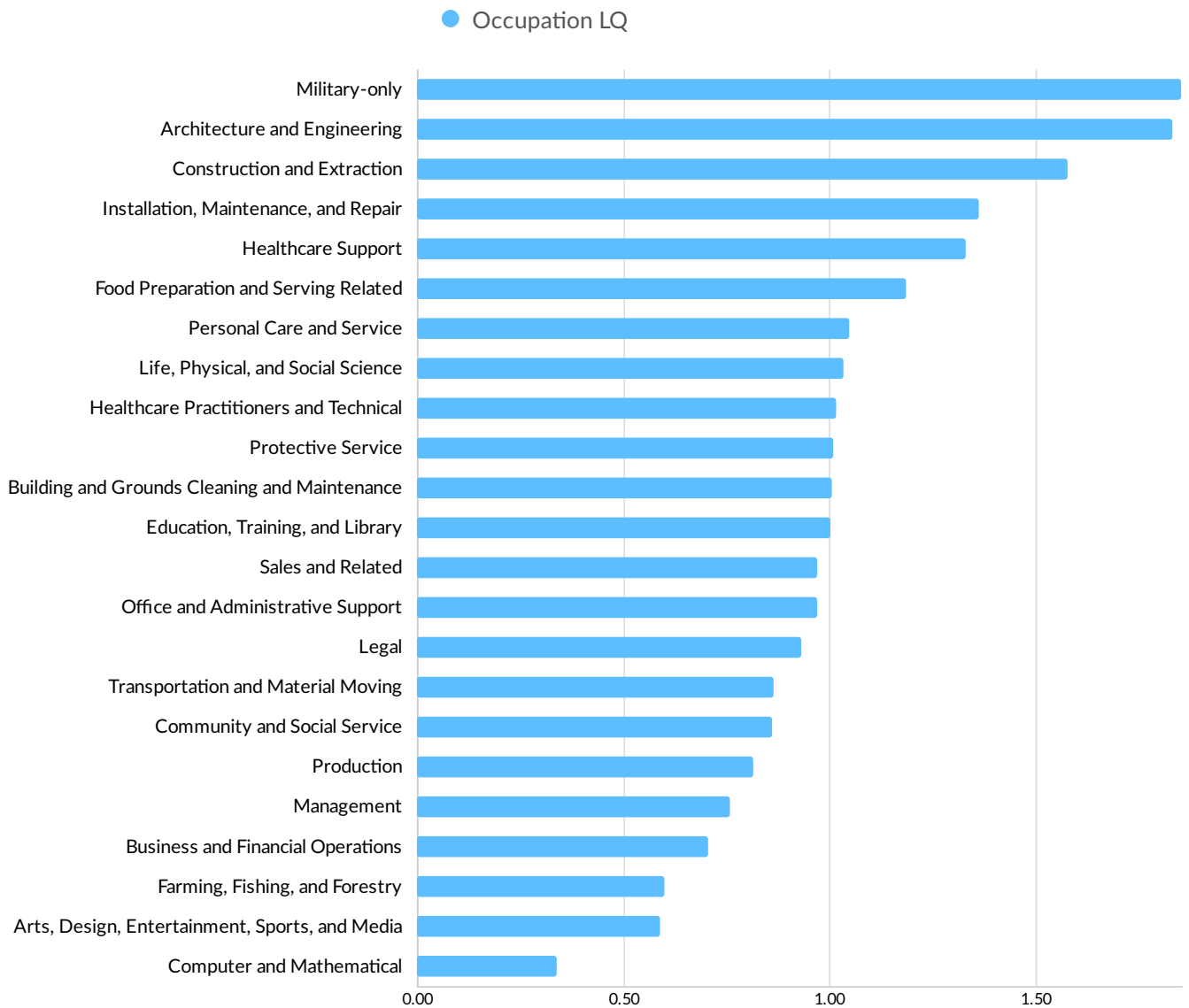

Top Growing Occupations



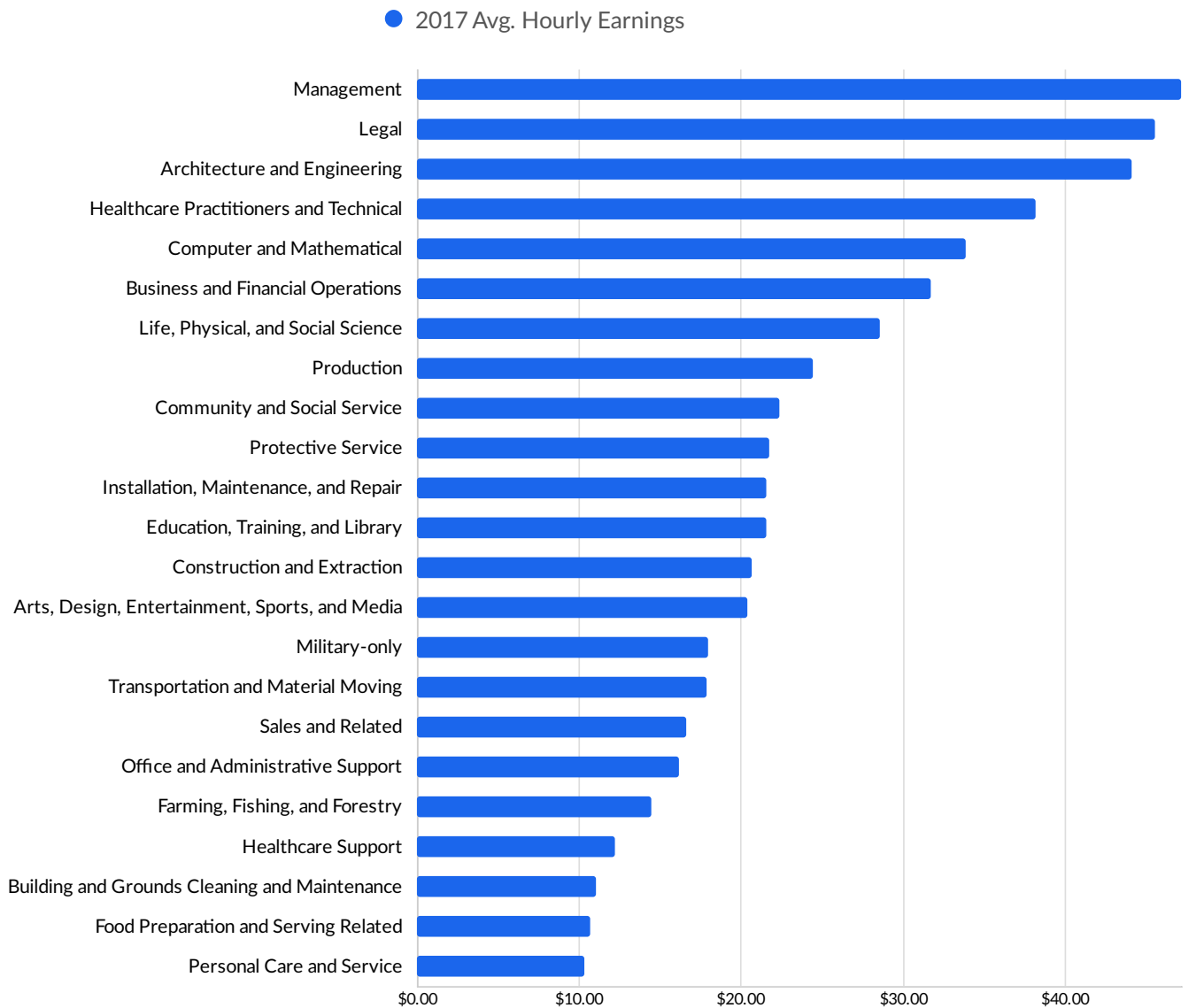

Top Occupation LQ



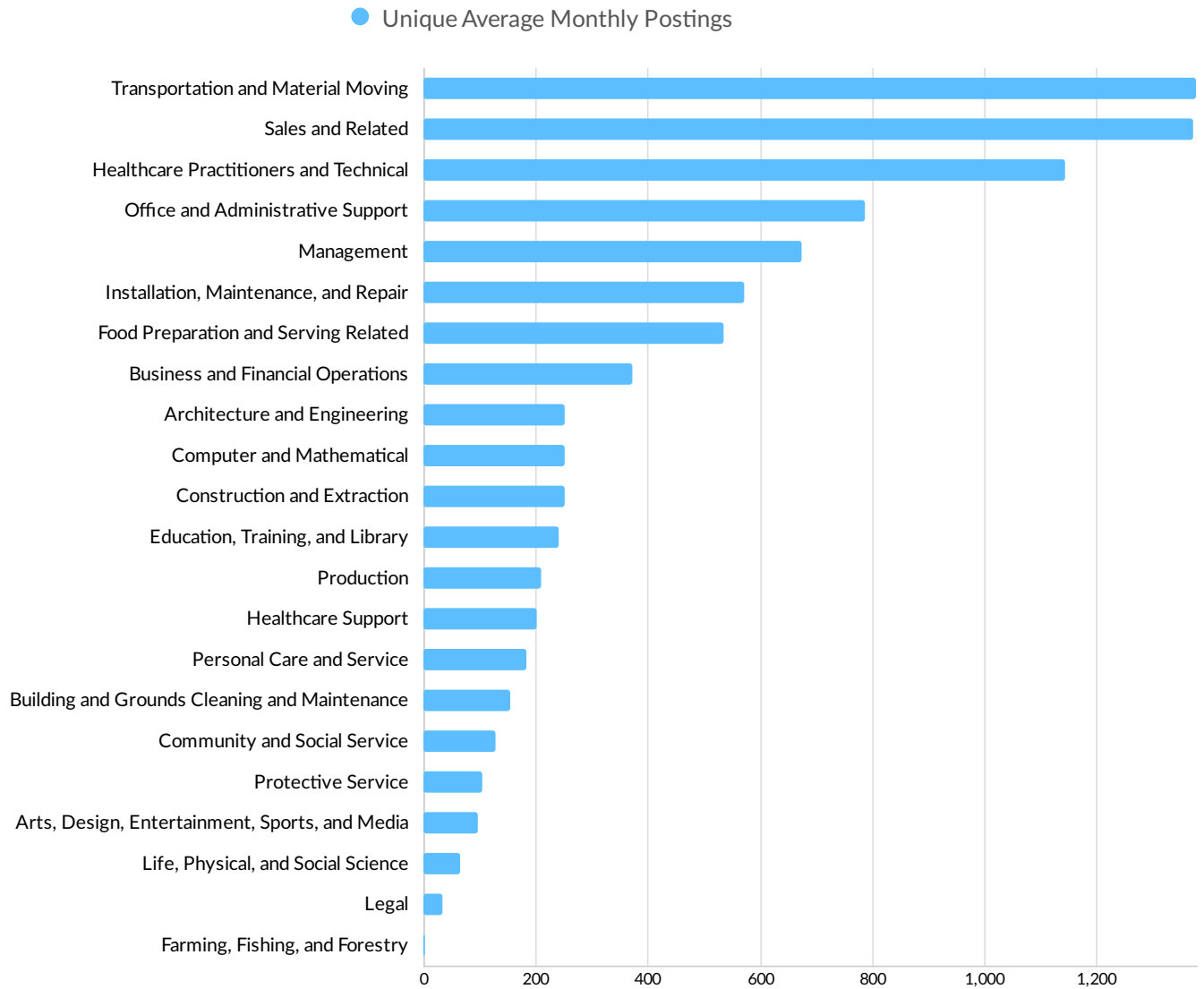

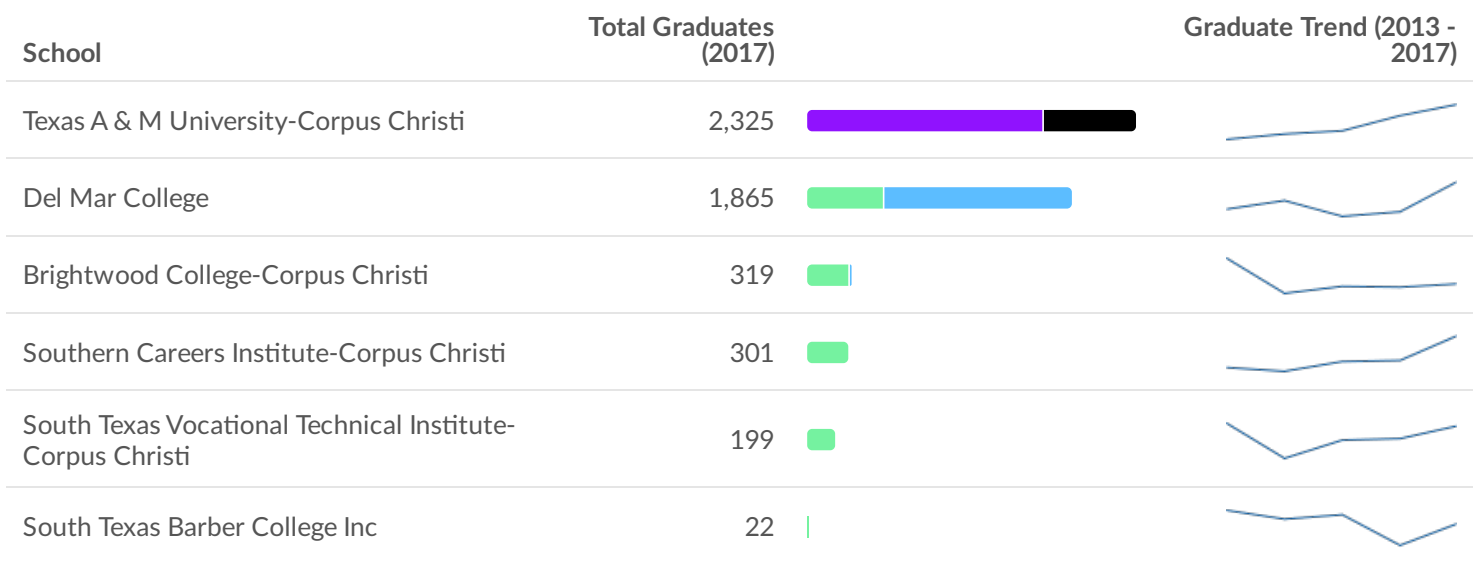
